


### OUR PURPOSE IS TO MAKE A CHILD'S BRIGHTEST FUTURE POSSIBLE AGAIN.



Each year, approximately 200 children and their families participate in one of our core programs: Residential Care, Crisis Care, Foster Care and Family Care.








In 2022, Connie Maxwell became accrediated by the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability.
